

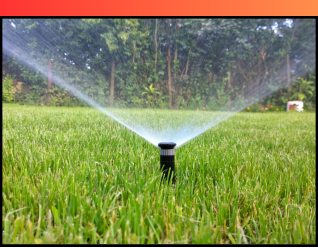


➤➤➤ FALL IS IN THE AIR
